

Swedish Vocabulary Crosswords for English Speakers - CEFR A2: The next step after A1: faster recall, stronger vocabulary, better accuracy (the CEFR Swedish A1-C1 series for English Speakers)

Move from “I recognise that word” to “I can produce it quickly” — using bilingual crosswords that force real recall.

This A2 book is built for English-speaking learners who already know the basics and want to make Swedish more usable in everyday situations. Each puzzle mixes English and Swedish inside the same grid, and the clues switch languages, so you constantly practise translation both ways:

- English clue → Swedish answer
- Swedish clue → English answer

That’s exactly the kind of mental flexibility learners need as they progress toward real-world Swedish — and toward certification goals.

What you’ll practise

- A2-level Swedish vocabulary, spelling and word recognition
- Faster recall under light “puzzle pressure” (a great training effect)
- Accurate handling of Swedish characters (Å/Ä/Ö)
- Bidirectional translation skills (English ↔ Swedish), reinforced by crossing letters

Why this format works

The grid gives you built-in checking: letters from one language support retrieval in the other. It’s a fun way to turn vocabulary study into a repeatable habit.
