### **Credible level focus**

Russian does not map perfectly onto CEFR, so this series keeps the CEFR structure while referencing the closest widely used exam framework: TORFL/TRKI. The A2 vocabulary is informed by the TORFL/TRKI Basic level (ТБУ) lexical-minimum approach and cross-checked against learner-facing level lists. The result is a practical A2 word bank suitable for systematic study and independently cross-referenced if required.

### **A note about the mixed grids**

Russian uses Cyrillic while English uses the Latin alphabet. To enable true cross-language intersections, the grids use a small set of Cyrillic capital letters that look identical to their Latin counterparts (for example, А/А, Е/Е, О/О, Р/Р, С/С, Т/Т, Х/Х). Visually, they look the same on the page; this is simply a technical method that allows English and Russian entries to cross cleanly.

### **Who this book is for**

- English-speaking learners who have completed A1 or have basic foundations and want a clear next step
- Travellers and expats who want practical vocabulary and better recall
- Teachers and tutors looking for quick, low-prep reinforcement activities

- Anyone who likes puzzles and wants steady, measurable progress

### **A simple study plan (optional, but highly effective)**

1. Attempt a puzzle without help for a few minutes.
2. Check the solution and mark missed entries.
3. Write down 5-10 words you missed.
4. Review them the next day and again one week later.

Do two or three puzzles per week for steady progress, or one per day for an intensive boost.

If you want a Russian A2 vocabulary book that feels rewarding, keeps you consistent, and genuinely improves recall, these 80 crosswords are the perfect next step.
